We are planning to do a club build-along of an affordable foamy in June. Let us know if you are interested. Plans are posted on the

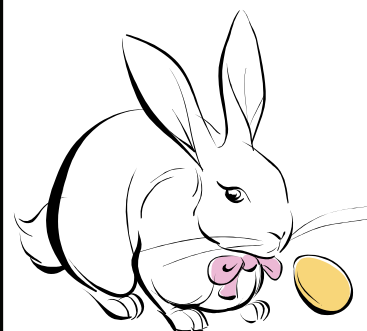

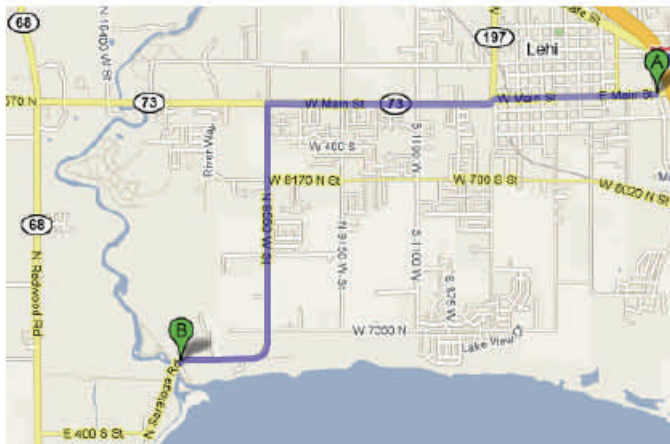
